Ask any guests not married to leave the dance floor, then couples married less than 1 year, 2, 5, 10, 15, etc. The last couple remaining on the dance floor is then presented with a bouquet of flowers from the bride & groom. These two couples then begin dancing to the next song, usually also a slow selection.
